Brummana High School currently offers two programmes, the Lebanese Programme and the International Programme. In both programmes the main language of instruction is English.

families working in Lebanon. All students in the International Programme also study Arabic and French. In the Upper School about 55% of our students are registered in the International Programme.

Support is offered to students sitting external exams such as the SAT Reasoning Test, SAT Subject Tests, and TOEFL. Every effort is made to integrate students from abroad with students in the Lebanese Programme. Up to Grade 8 students in the International Programme and the Lebanese Programme are in mixed classes, wherever possible. Students are streamed in some subjects to ensure that each student works at his/her proficiency level in a given year. In this way, skills are strengthened and smaller classes allow for greater individual attention.



The Lebanese Programme

The Lebanese Programme is designed to fulfil the requirements of the Lebanese Ministry of Education. The school therefore prepares its students for the Lebanese government Brevet and Lebanese Baccalaureate exam. Students have the choice of the Lebanese Baccalaureate in Life Sciences, General Sciences, or Sociology and Economics. The Lebanese Baccalaureate qualifies the students for entry into the sophomore year of university in Lebanon and many universities abroad. In the Upper School about 45% of our students are registered in the Lebanese Programme.

The International Programme

The International Programme leads to a High School Diploma or the International Baccalaureate, with all students sitting for the British IGCSE exams. These students are generally from Lebanese families returning



English as a Foreign Language (EFL)

Students who do not speak English follow an intensive course in order to acquire sufficient skill in English and other subjects to be able to join the mainstream programme of study within a short period of time.



Background: Life in a boarding school is a unique experience for young people as they mature into young adults. As they experience the responsibilities and pleasures of communal life, our students become more self-reliant and self-confident. Working together to build a peaceful and harmonious community, they learn the need for self-discipline and to care for others. We know that our past students have formed friendships which they cherish



long after they have left Brummana High School. Throughout its history, Brummana High School has had a well-established boarding section. Our students come from a variety of backgrounds and nationalities.

Age: We accept boarders from Grade 5 (Upper Elementary Section). If accompanied by older siblings, we accept younger students from Grade 4.

Accommodation: There are two boarding houses available, one for girls and one for boys. A maximum of two students sleep in each room, and the

school prides itself on the comfort and spaciousness of the dormitories. There are also recreation rooms and sitting rooms where students can relax, watch television, play table tennis, billiards, and babyfoot with friends or other students.
