TENTH MEETING OF THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS

WEDNESDAY DECEMBER 21ST 1960

1. Mr. Edden explained that the object of this meeting was to report on the progress of the Appeal so far and to discuss means of a further "drive". So far £1,000 had been received from the "Mother Cat Co.", and Dr. Hitti produced a cheque for £L,5000 from Mr. Charles Kettaneh (£L3000 on behalf of Kettaneh Bros and £L2,000 on his own behalf).
2. Dr. Hitti proposed and it was agreed that H.E. the Ambassador should be asked to consider a personal approach to M. Henri Pharaon to discover whether he, the latter, would be agreeable to calling a meeting of a selected number of Sponsors to guide the Governors and the Appeal sub-Committee on the best methods of pursuing the Appeal. Mr. Edden agreed to put this proposal to the Ambassador. (Item 2 of the Third Meeting of the Appeal Sub-Committee refers).
3. It was agreed that Messrs. Russell and Co., Chartered Accountants, should be asked to undertake the audit of the School and Appeal Accounts. Mr. Catoni agreed to approach Mr. Scott-Smith on this point.
4. It was agreed that a letter of thanks be sent to the National Cash Register Co. for their services in producing the Appeal Letters.
5. It was agreed that Mr. T. Jabbour's reimbursement for his services for the Appeal Committee should be £L.150/- per month provisionally.
6. It was recommended that the Appeal Sub-Committee should be asked to consider approaching Hotel owners and companies.

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
