Very many thanks for your letter of July 1st. I am very pleased, and so is the Ambassador, that Najib Antoun's case has been settled in this way. It is true that the Board of Governors has to pay LL.500, which they really should not have been called upon to pay, but it is worth this for the case to have been settled amicably.

As I agreed with you, if Najib Antoun expected some kind of reasonable settlement, we will give consideration to the employment of him and other members of the family when the school starts. I am not, of course, in a position to promise him now a definite job, but I would regard the present settlement as being an amicable one and perhaps put on record that he and his family should be given favourable consideration.

I am asking the Honorary Treasurer to send you a cheque for LL.568 in settlement of the fees and the sum to be paid to Najib Antoun.

I hereby acknowledge the return of the title deeds which you had.
