Dear Ian,

Re-Najib Antoun.

I am happy to inform you that the case of Najib Antoun has been amicably settled.

At the hearing last Wednesday, Antoun obtained a week's adjournment for the purpose of settling. Since that date I had several meetings with him and with his lawyer Mr. Boustani. We finally reached agreement on the following basis:

1. Payment of LL. 1000 (of which half will be paid by Badri Tali).
2. Allocation of building materials from the Department of Reconstruction.
3. A delay of six weeks to permit him to build elsewhere.

The above agreement was recorded in Court on Saturday and has been embodied in the form of a final court judgment which can be executed at a moment's notice. You will no doubt agree that this is a satisfactory end to the affair.

I should mention that I had given assurances to Najib Antoun that at the first opportunity he and possibly his son would be given some employment. The son is a young man who has had some education, and I wonder if anything can be done for him.

The expenses of the action i.e. power of attorney, Court fees etc. amounted to LL. 68, to which should be added LL. 500, as agreed.

I enclose the title deeds.
