Sir,

I am directed by Her Britannic Majesty's Ambassador to enclose the cheque books for the two accounts held with your Bank in favour of the English School in the Lebanon. In view of the decision taken yesterday by the Board of Governors that these accounts should be operated jointly by Dr. Joseph Hitti as Chairman of the Board of Governors and by yourself as Treasurer, the previous instructions whereby the Ambassador and myself, and later Mr. Tesh, were authorised to operate these accounts are now cancelled.
