Dr. Joseph Hitti, Chairman of the Board of Governors of the proposed English Public School, has, he tells me, discussed with you the possibility of your becoming an additional Honorary Legal Adviser to the School and that you have kindly indicated your willingness to act in this capacity.

I write therefore, at Dr. Hitti's suggestion, to confirm his request and shall take steps to bring this matter before the next Meeting of the Board of Governors for their information.
