BRUMMANA HIGH SCHOOL ANNUAL GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

In order to be granted a school diploma whether in the Lebanese or International Programmes, students must, throughout Secondary School in Grades 10, 11 and 12:

- 1. Complete Community Service requirements
- 2. Maintain a satisfactory disciplinary record

The Lebanese Programme

In order to graduate from the Lebanese Programme, BHS students must:

- 1. Successfully achieve an overall average of at least 65% in Grades 10 and 11
- 2. Be deemed ready to be in either the Grade 11 Sciences or Humanities at the end of Grade 10 (for Grade 11)
- 3. Be deemed ready to be in either the General Science, Life Science or Sociology and Economics section at the end of Grade 11 (for Grade 12)

The International Programme

(a) The Cambridge Diploma

In order to graduate from the Cambridge Diploma Programme, BHS students must:

- 1. Acquire 5 IGCSE's in Grade 10 with a minimum grade of C (Commencing from June 2020 to enter Grade 11 A/S level)
- 2. Acquire 7 IGCSE's in Grade 10 IP with a minimum grade of C (Commencing from June 2021 to enter Grade 11 A/S level)
- 3. Acquire at least 4 A/S levels in Grade 11 with a minimum grade of D (Commencing from June 2022 to enter Grade 12 A level)
- 4. Acquire at least 3 A levels in Grade 12 with a minimum grade of D (Commencing from June 2023 in order to graduate)

N.B. Students with A levels may wish to apply for an equivalence at the Ministry of Education provided they take an IGCSE in Arabic with a minimum grade of C. Such students will enter the university in Lebanon at the sophomore year.

(b) The International Baccalaureate

In order to graduate from the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme, BHS students must:

- 1. Successfully achieve an overall average of at least 65% in IB1
- 2. Be deemed ready to be in IB2 at the end of IB1
