You do not ever put up with being on the receiving end of a bully on Snapchat.

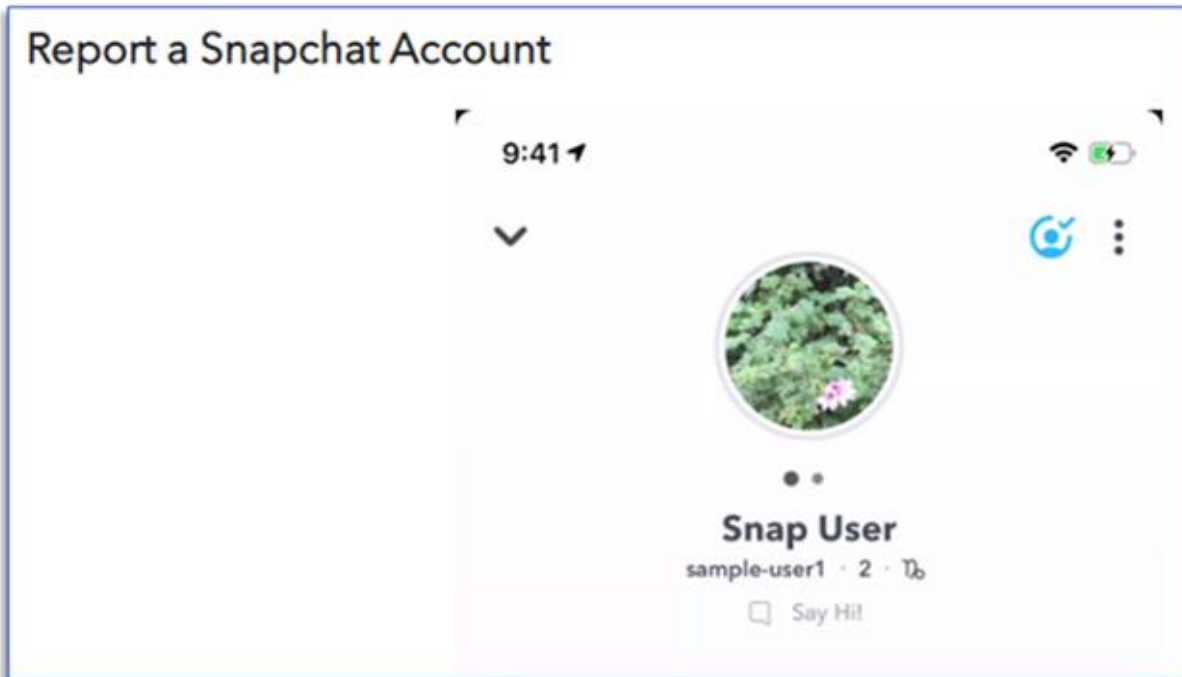
- 1) On Snapchat Privacy is automatically private

Only 'Friends' you've added on Snapchat can contact you directly or view your Story.

Always take screen shots of cyberbullying. Keep those screen shots safe.

Report a Snapchat Account





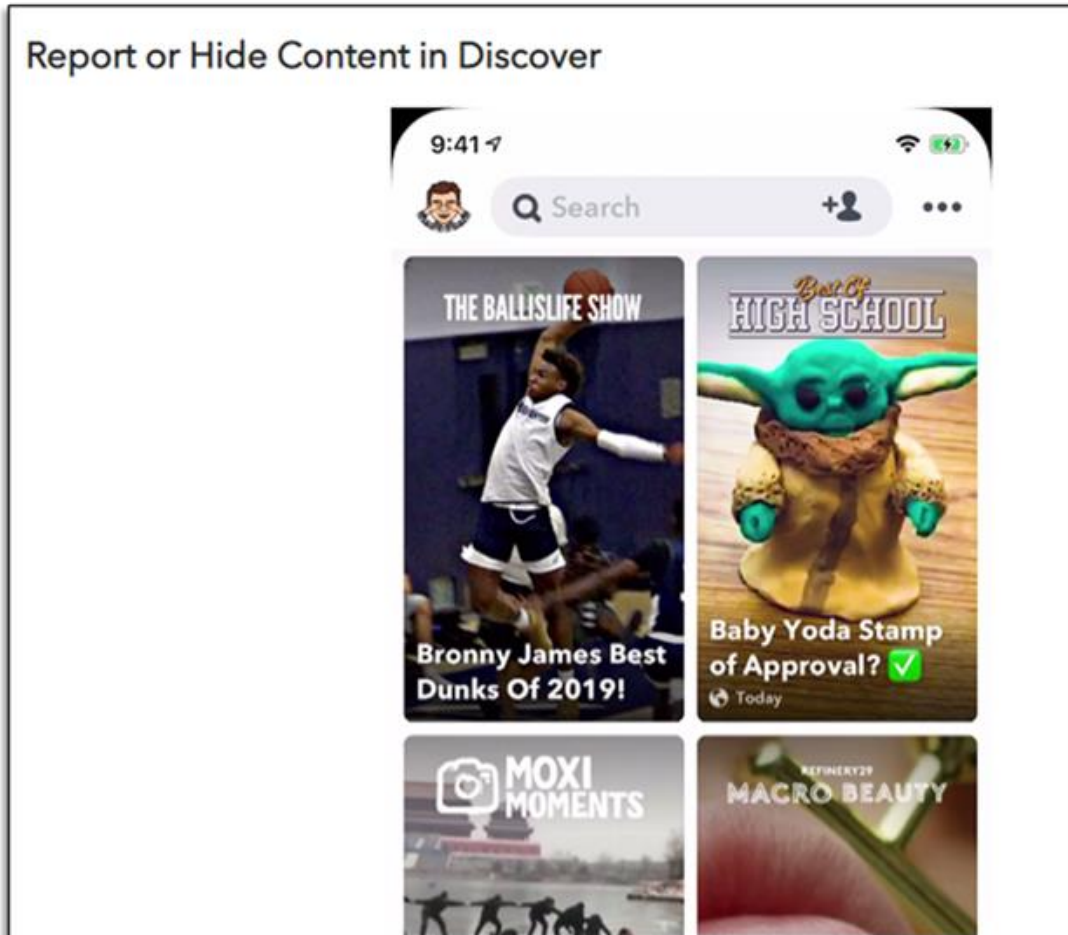
1. Press and hold on the Snapchatter's name,
2. Tap 'More,'
3. Tap 'Report.'

Report a Snap or Story on Snapchat



To report a Snap or Story

1. Press and hold on it until  appears at the bottom of the screen.
2. Tap  to let us know what's going on.



To report content in Discover,

- 1) Press and hold on the tile.
- 2) Tap 'Report Tile.'
