WHAT TO EXPECT

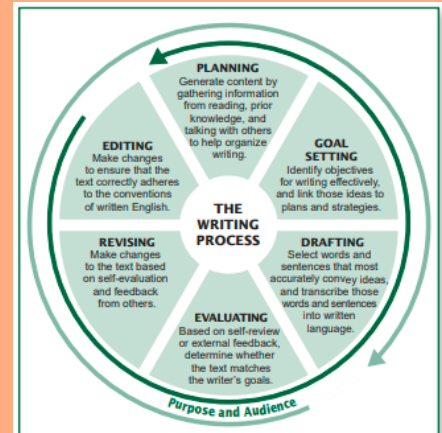
This workshop is aimed to help you learn how to conduct valid research and write a professional academic essay.
