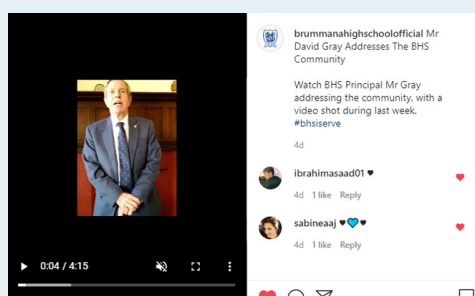

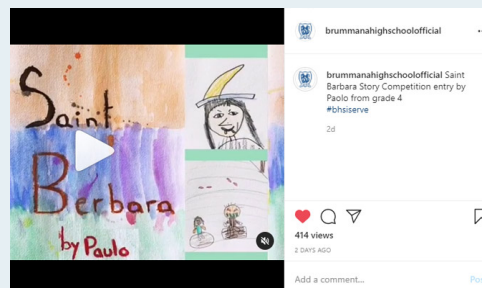

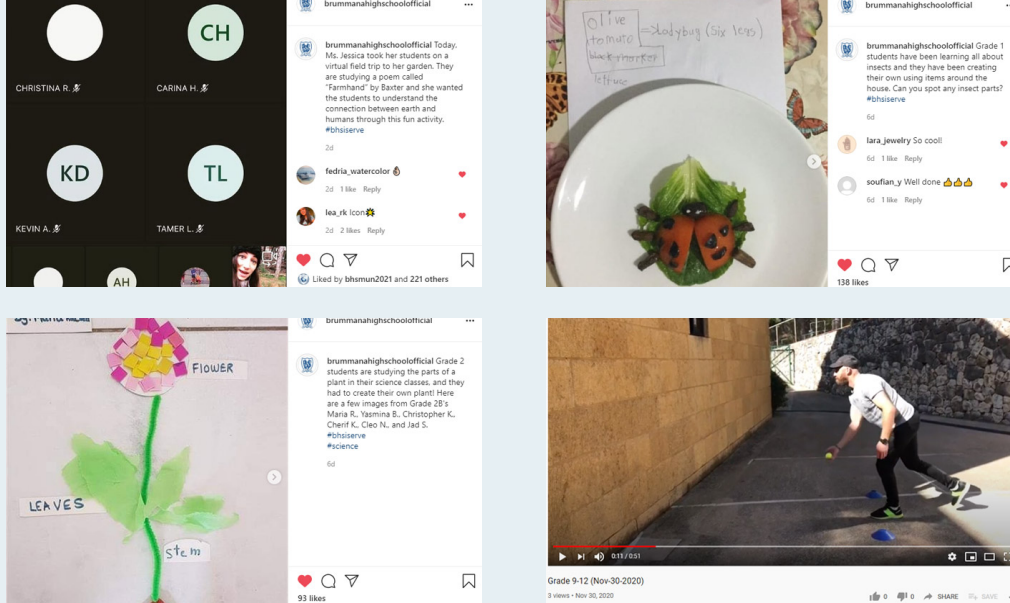

Principal's First Meeting with Prefects

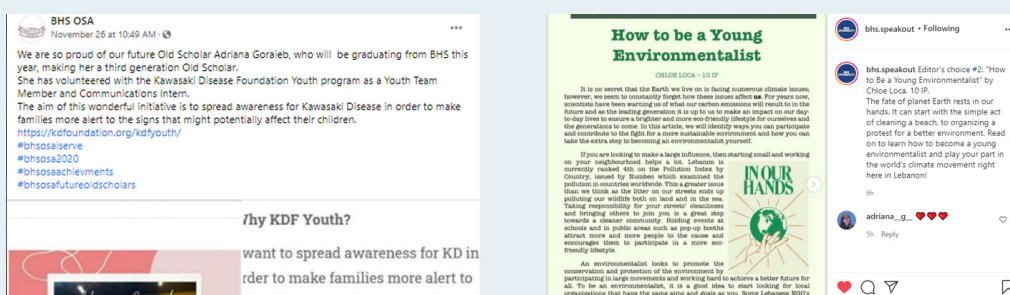
