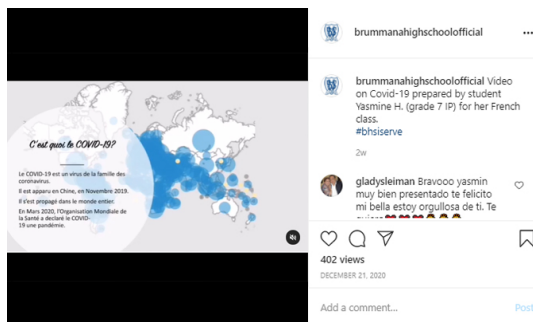
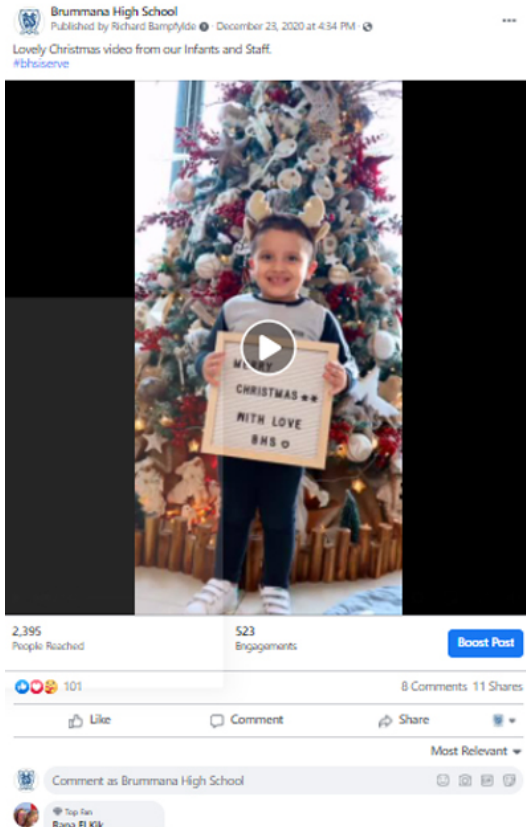
END OF TERM Intermediate Assembly
