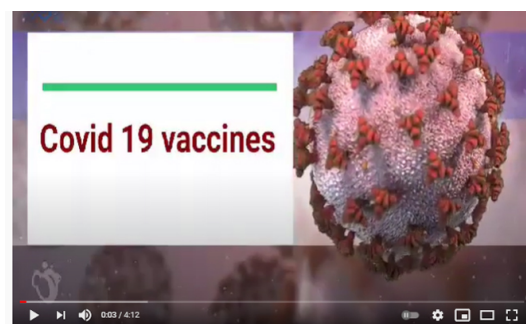

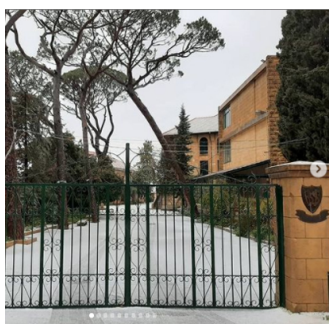

Did you know that the name 'Brummana' is believed to be Aramaic which most probably means 'house of Rammana, the God of Air, Storm and Thunder'? In the location where Brummana was built, it was thought that the god Rammanu lived there, which gave it the name 'House of Rammanu', and it is known that the letter B at the beginning of the name of villages refers to 'beit' in Syriac, meaning 'house'.
