Masks (including spares).



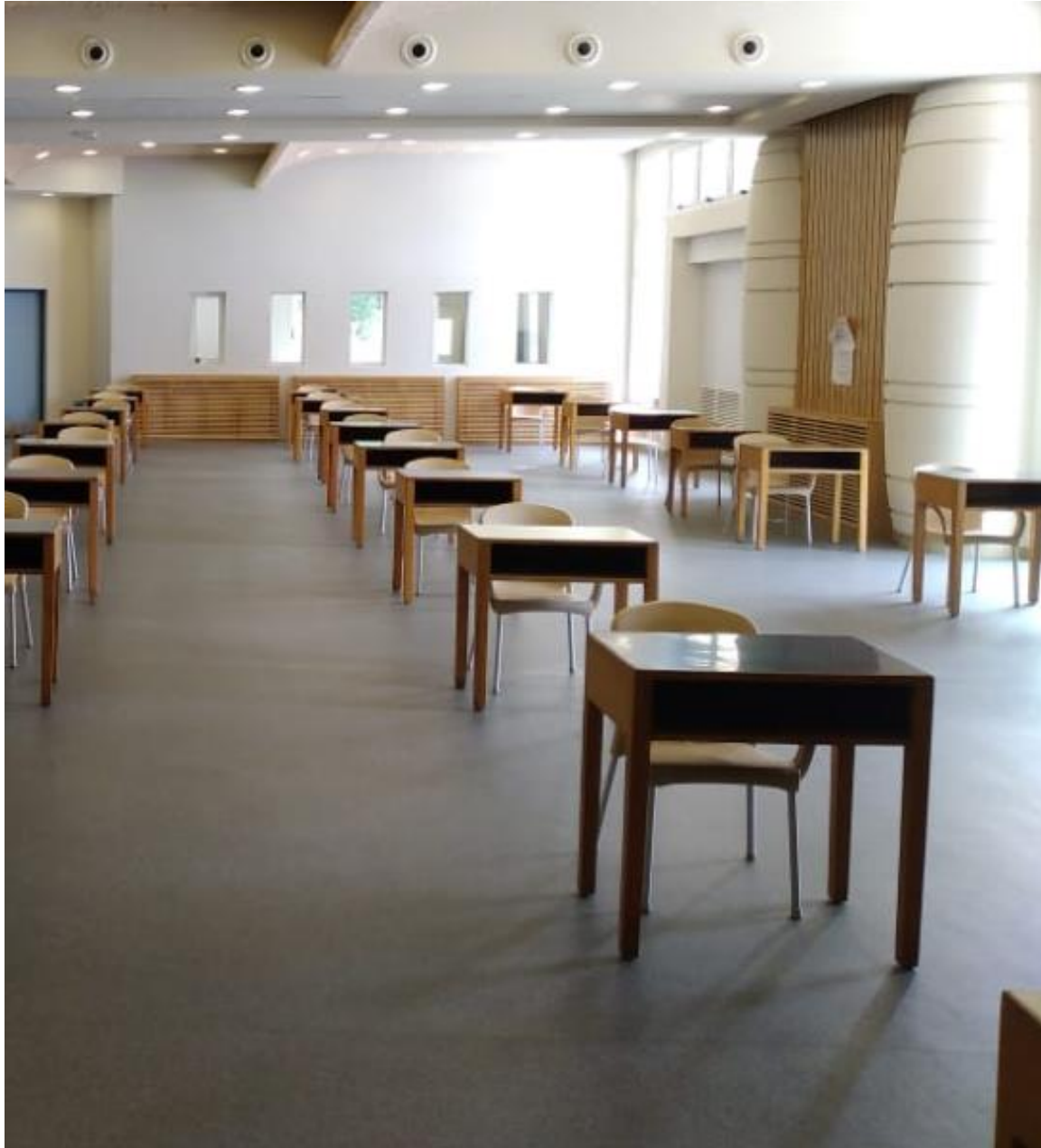
Personal hand sanitizer- hand sanitizer will be available.

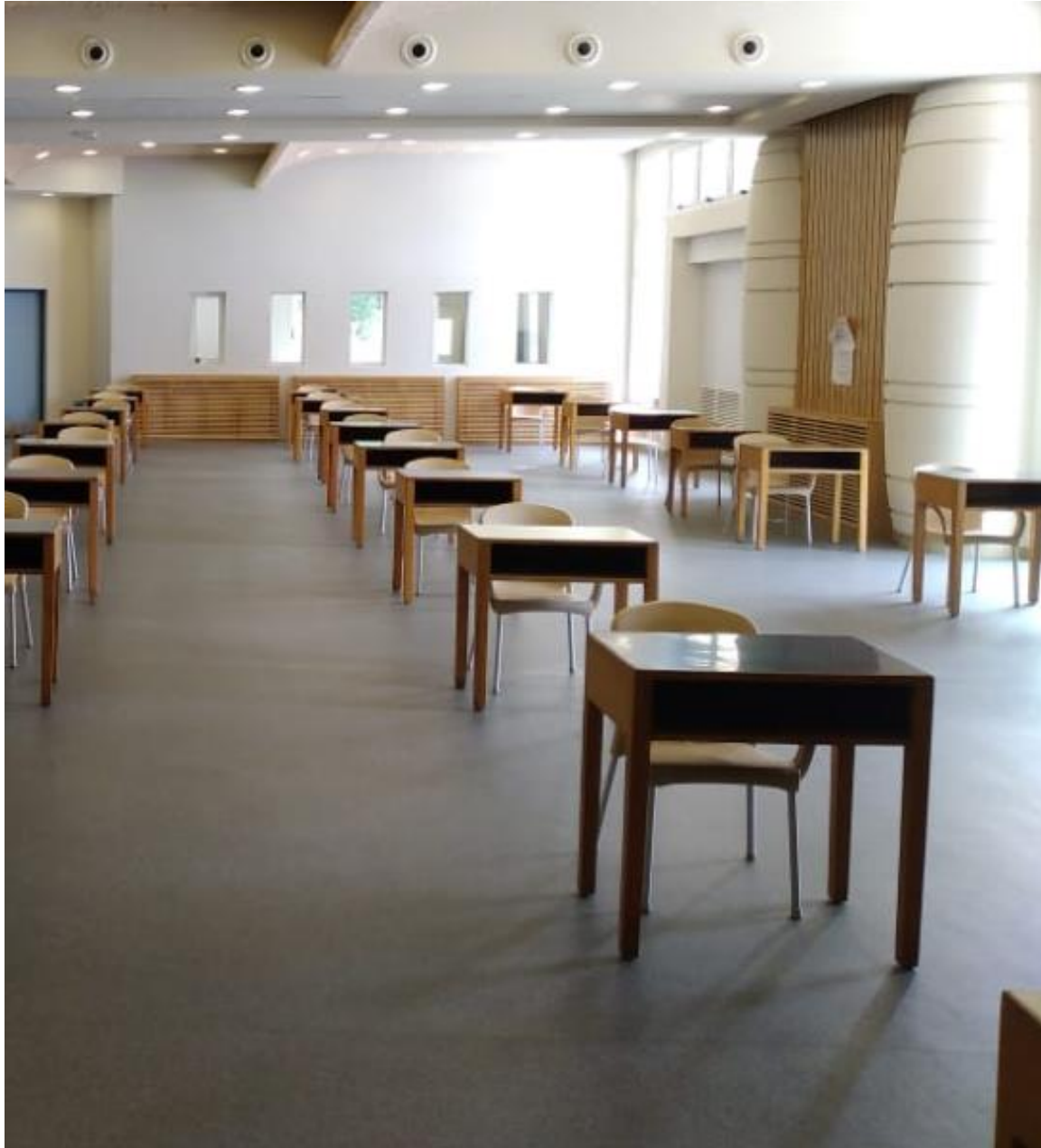
