

I trust this email finds you and your loved ones keeping well.

On this day one year ago, the lives of so many changed forever. The Beirut Port explosion on August 4th 2020 remains etched on the minds of the local and international community. Certainly, August 4th AUAD remains excised on the minors of the local and international community. Let's the large white plumes of smoke travelling at incomprehensible speed towards the Lebanes capital will never be forgotten by all of us who watched those videos. The great many who persished, were mailmed, or lost their life/indoods shows the trapely caused by the devastating blast. The physical and mental challenges for survivors remain with so many in the population

To mark the occasion, I am presenting a webinar at the UK's Quaker Yearly Meeting as well as sharing this communication with our whole school community. This evening's presentation, delivered along with our Qulfi Trustees, will mark the tragic event as well as highlight the unbelievable support the school received following the explosion. The Beinut Fund attracted over \$70,000, providing much welcomed tuition for relief to school families affected by the blast, and BHS supporters have gifted over \$220,000 in total to the various school funds over the last 12 months.

supporters have gired over \$2,20,000 in total to the vanous school tunus over the last 1 e months. The presentation will also provide an update on the current situation in Lebanon which frankly seems to go from bad to worse, with a crumbling economy, hyper-inflation, a local currency at less than 10% tis original value and unemployment and poverty rates both above 50%. The Covid-19 pandemic has further compounded the challenging situation in Lebanon. Tonight I will also mention an extremely generous additional domation recently received from the BHS Cld Scholars. Association which provided a one-month salary bonus to every teacher and staff member at the school.
