Week 44: *Alnus orientalis*, commonly known as Oriental alder, belongs to the Betulaceae family. This deciduous tree is native to southeastern Europe and western Asia. It prefers moist or wet areas such as riverbanks, floodplains, and areas with high water tables. On the same tree, male and female flowers are borne separately. The yellow male flowers hang in long, cascading clusters, while the female flowers are a bit elongated and spherical. A recently planted tree stands on the school premises, just below the cafeteria's kitchen. As part of the school's 150th-anniversary celebrations, the curator of Brummana High School Botanical Garden will dedicate a section of our weekly bulletin to highlight 150 plants currently flourishing on our campus. Every week, one plant will be profiled for its scientific and cultural significance. Our ultimate goal is to shed some light on the rich and diverse plant collection present on our campus, because, as the legendary naturalist Lord David Attenborough once said, "No one will protect what they don't care about; and no one will care about what they have never experienced."
