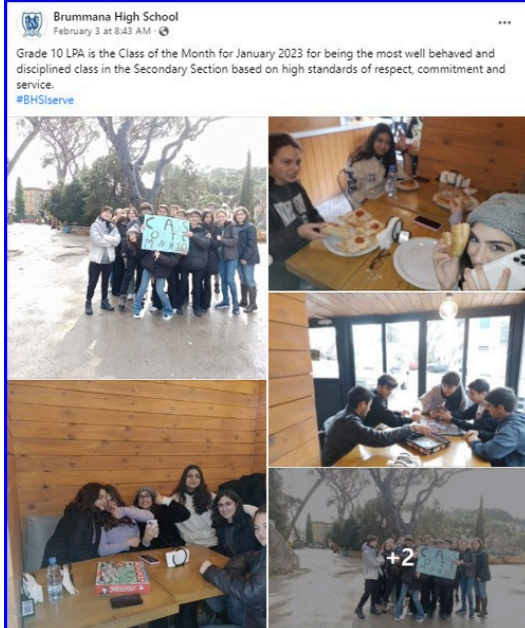

WEEK 3: The native fern plant, Venus Hair, is the most elegant of the four fern species growing on campus. 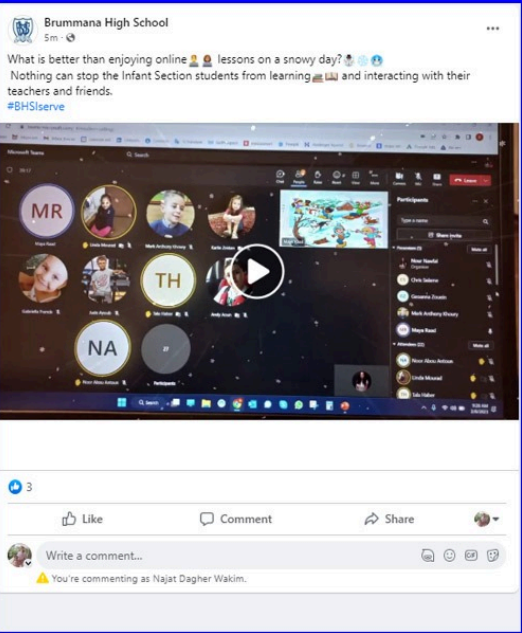

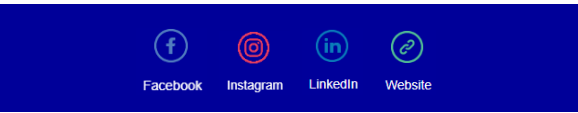
