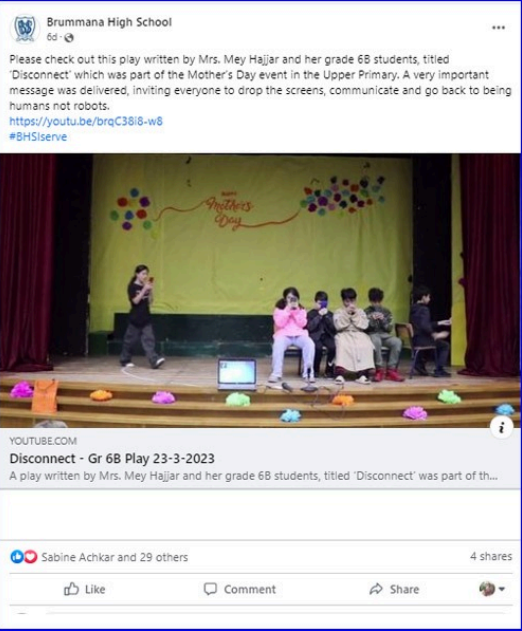
Brevet Recycling Project:
