Week 18: Tall birthwort (Aristolochia altissima - Aristolochiacea).

Aristolochia altissima flowers have a specific method of pollination, consisting of a tube-like structure with a slippery surface that serves as a trap for particular files. Trapped insects can't get out at once, thereby increasing the likelihood of contact with pollen. The flower eventually releases the captured insects, allowing them to carry pollen to other plants.

Certain Aristolochia species have been used in traditional medicine to induce labor, alleviate menstrual cramps, and treat other gynecological issues. Hence, the name "birthwort."

On campus, a small Aristolochia altissima climiber can be found at the Mother Tree's base. Look on the backside of the main trunk.

As part of the school's 150th-anniversary celebrations, the curator of Brummana High School Botanical Garden will dedicate a section of our weekly builetin to highighit 150 plants that are currently floundshing on our campus. Every week, one plant will be profiled for its scientific and cultural significance. Our ultimate goal is to shed some light on the rich and diverse plant collection present on our campus, because, as the legendary naturalist Lord David Atterborough once said, "No one will protect what they don't care about; and no one will care about what they have never experienced."
