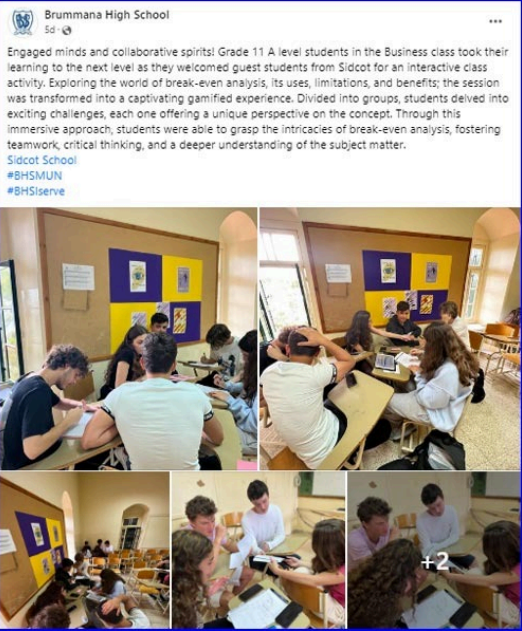

Week 19: Tall birthwort (*Bougainvillea glabra* - Nyctaginaceae).
Bougainvillea glabra is a tropical flowering climber native to South America. It is a popular ornamental plant known for its vibrant and showy bracts that surround small, inconspicuous flowers.
On campus, it is probably the plant that you will directly locate. This glorious climber has literally conquered the entire corner of the Main Teaching Block, greeting you with a magnificent display of purple colour from May onwards until December.
As part of the school's 150th-anniversary celebrations, the curator of Brummana High School Botanical Garden will dedicate a section of our weekly bulletin to highlight 150 plants that are currently flourishing on our campus.
