Catalpa speciose is a large deciduous tree native to the central and eastern parts of the United
States. One of the most distinctive features is its large, trumpet-shaped flowers with frilly white
petals and purple or yellow spots and markings inside. Native American tribes used the inner bark
and roots of Catalpa speciosa for medicinal purposes.
