Bus Rules

Students on the bus must abide by the school rules, respect the designated monitor, and follow these BHS bus rules:

1. Get on and off the bus in an orderly manner in single file.
2. No physical play or rough conduct is allowed at any time.
3. Remain properly seated at all times and keep head and other parts of the body inside the bus and out of the aisle.
4. All students travelling by bus must wear the seat belts provided, for their safety and security. Any student refusing to wear a seatbelt will be asked to leave the bus and the parents will be called to collect the child. If a child removes the seatbelt during the journey, the bus driver will stop the bus and parents will be called to collect the child. In addition, the child will be placed in detention.
5. Avoid loud conversation and singing.
6. Musical instruments may not be played inside the bus.
7. Ask the bus monitor's permission before opening a window.
8. Eating, drinking, chewing gum, and smoking are not allowed on the bus.
9. Respect the rights of others inside and outside the bus.
10. Written parental permission is required if a bus registered student who comes to school in the morning is not using the usual bus on the homeward journey (because he/she is not returning by bus).
11. Occasional change of bus routes is not allowed.
12. Permanent change of destinations during the academic year is subject to the availability of places on the new bus and acceptable disruption of the set journey.
13. A student who is not registered to use the bus service may not use a BHS bus, unless it is a BHS sanctioned activity.
14. A student who misbehaves on the bus will be reported to the Head of Section. A student who repeatedly misbehaves on the bus will be banned from using it.
